I am so surprised to see that matured, excellent, great counselor like Ahithophel, who once was so faithful to King David turned against him and joined hand with his son Absalom to take revenge of David. Of course, Absalom gained sympathy of others, even of Ahithophel who with Absalom conspired against David.

It is sad to know that the same trick is being played by unsatisfied souls in the body of Christ against the leader. They gain the sympathy of others by gossiping and tale bearings. And others who seem to be matured people like Ahithophel fall prey to their tricks and join hand with them and support them to cause total destruction of God's work. And I have personally experienced this kind of hear-aching, destructive behavior of so-called men of God. This is really disgusting! It is very painful to know the result of Absalom for his rebellion against his father King David!

It is high time for us to check our hearts in the light of the Word of God and see whether we are slightly tending towards this kind of behavior and get back to the Word of God with repentant heart and be a blessing to the work of God and not to become channel of destruction of God's work.
