GIVE UNTO THE LORD HIS GLORY

“7. And Moses went out to meet his father in law, and did obeisance, and kissed him; and they asked each other of their welfare; and they came into the tent. 8. And Moses told his father in law all that the LORD had done unto Pharaoh and to the Egyptians for Israel`s sake, and all the travail that had come upon them by the way, and hoe the LORD delivered them. 9. And Jethro, rejoiced for all the goodness which the LORD had done to Israel, whom he had delivered out of the hand of the Egyptians. 10. And Jethro said, blessed be the LORD, who hath delivered you out of the hand of the Egyptians, and out the hand of Pharaoh, who hath delivered the people from under the hand of the Egyptians.”

We as the children of God must give all the glory due unto His Name, keeping in mind what our good God has said, “I am the LORD: that is my name: and my glory will I not give to another, neither my praise to graven images” (Isaiah 42:8).

In above passage of Scripture we see that Moses and Jethro, his father in law they both gave glory to God due unto His Name! Moses could have taken all the credit for himself to bring Israel people out of the bondage of Egyptians. But He did not utter any word about himself but while telling his father in law Jethro what God Almighty did in the lives of Israel people and how He delivered them out of the hand of the Pharaoh the Egyptian king: “And Moses told his father in law all that the LORD had done unto Pharaoh and to the Egyptians for Israel`s sake, and all the travail that had come upon them by the way, and hoe the LORD delivered them” (Vs 8).

Also here we see another thing that Jethro the father in law of Moses did the same thing: “9. And Jethro, rejoiced for all the goodness which the LORD had done to Israel, whom he had delivered out of the hand of the Egyptians. 10. And Jethro said, blessed be the LORD, who hath delivered you out of the hand of the Egyptians, and out the hand of Pharaoh, who hath delivered the people from under the hand of the Egyptians” (vs. 9-10).

Both men while talking to each other did not boast of themselves neither they took credit for themselves for the work they did, but they both gave glory to God Alone due unto His Name! We as a Christian and especially ministers of God should always keep in mind that whatever work we do under the leadership and anointing of the Lord we should give all the glory to His Name. For He Only deserves our praise, honor and glory! We are just vessels in His Hand and we should count ourselves privileged that He has chosen us and believed in us that we would be obedient to His call on our lives and we would be faithful in our duties towards Him. And each and every time we should give all the glory to His Name for any success or victory we get in our day to day life and work for Him. We cannot do anything on our own but we should allow Him to do and work in us and through us and He is the Author and Finisher and no one else! All the glory, honor and praise belong to Him Alone!

“Give unto the LORD the glory due unto his name: bring an offering, and come before him: worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness” (I Chronicles 16:29; Psalms 29:2; Psalms 96:8).
