

In the second Chronicles chapter 20 we see that the children of Moab and the children of Ammon with others came against Jehoshaphat to battle. King Jehoshaphat feared to see this. He proclaimed a fast throughout all Judah and set himself to seek the LORD. After King Jehoshaphat finished his prayer the Spirit of the LORD came upon Jahaziel and he said, 'hearken ye, all Judah, and ye inhabitants of Jerusalem, and thou King Jehoshaphat, thus saith the LORD unto you, be not afraid nor dismayed by the reason of this great multitude; for the battle is not yours, but God's" (II Chronicles 20 1-15).
