

"67. And Jesus unto the twelve, will ye also go away?"

68. Then Simon Peter answered him, Lord, to whom shall we go? **Thou hast the words of eternal life.**" (John 6:67-68).

Jesus was talking to Jews when they went seeking for him. They asked him, "Rabbi, when camest thou hither?" Jesus told them that they did not seek him because they saw miracles he did but they did seek him because they ate bread and got filled. He told them to believe on him. (John 6:25-28).

During the conversation, Jews asked Jesus to show sign then they will believe him. Jews told Jesus that their forefathers ate manna in the desert, the bread from heaven. Jesus told them that about the true bread which gives life to the world (John 6:32). Jews people asked for that bread to Jesus.

And thereafter the conversation starts (John 6:8-50). And further Jesus tell them most important thing to have eternal life, "Verily, verily, I say unto you, except ye eat the flesh of the Son of man, and drink his blood, ye have not life in you (vs. 53).

"60. Many therefore of his disciples, when they had heard this, said, this is an hard saying who can hear it?" 66. From that time many of his disciples went back, and walked no more with him" (John 6:60, 66).

Most of Jesus` disciples were offended at his teaching them the Truth. Most of them left him for good. Today also we see same thing happening. Most of us who hear the Word of God we get offended and just walk away from the Truth. Jesus said, "And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free" (John 8:32). "I am the way, the truth, and the life...." (John 14:6). Further he said, "Sanctify them through thy truth, thy word is truth" (John 17:17).

Jesus Christ is the Word of Life!" "That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, and our hands have handled of the Word of life" (I John 1:1).

And thank the Lord that this is second time Peter got the revelation from the Heavenly Father: "...Lord to whom shall we go? **Thou hast the words of eternal life!**"

It is our great privilege given by God Himself to us that we can go to Jesus at any time. Without Jesus we cannot do anything (John 15:5b). He said he will not cast us out when we go to him: "...and him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out" (John 6L37). No matter what situation we are in or what challenges we are facing, what worries bothering us, the care of our lives, sickness, financial problems, opposition or whatever may be the matter. Only Jesus has the solution. Only he can solve our problems. By believing on him we get forgiveness of sins, and eternal life. Not only that we can go to him at anytime and share our hearts with him. And the great Hymn tells us that:

What a Friend we have in Jesus,
All our sins and griefs to bear!
What a privilege to carry
everything to God in prayer!
O what peace we often forfeit,
O what needless pain we bear,
All because we do not carry
Everything to God in prayer!
